Teach with explicit routines / Enseñanza

Preview

Model the task and point to each visual area before the learner begins.

Practice

Review sounds - blend words - read the sentence - reread - answer - explain.

Respond

Accept pointing, arranging, circling, stamps, writing, AAC or spoken answers.

Review

Return to a known page for success before introducing a harder sentence.

Bilingual language safeguard / Lenguaje

What is assessed

Only the English sentence is the decoding target. Spanish supports meaning and must not be scored as an English decoding task.

Say both meanings

Read the English target first, then offer Spanish meaning support if useful.

Do not force translation

A child may show understanding with a picture, gesture or either language.

Natural language

Spanish support favors natural meaning rather than copying English word order.

Access and differentiation / Acceso

Reduce the field

Cover extra choices, present two options and uncover more only when needed.

Respond without writing

Use pointing, eye gaze, magnetic letters, tiles, stamps, partner scanning or AAC.

Increase challenge

Ask for a new sentence, a reason, a word change or a second reading with expression.

Short sessions

Use 5-10 minute practice, stop before fatigue and revisit the same pattern later.

Developmental use and safety / Uso

Accuracy before speed

Build accurate recognition and phrasing before tracking faster reading.

No guessing from art

Pictures support meaning; learners still attend to every printed word.

Supervise cutting

Cut-apart tiles and small pieces require adult supervision and safe storage.

Observe strategy

Record the cue and response mode, not only correct or incorrect.

Answer key / Clave de respuestas

Color and low-ink answers match. Spanish support is meaning guidance, not a literal word-order key.
